## SUPPLEMENTARY STUDY GRANTS – OFFER

American Fund for Czechoslovak Relief, Inc., offers supplementary study grants, each in the amount of \$2,000 to junior Czech or Slovak scholars, graduate students, university or comparable higher education institutions academic faculty.

These grants are intended to supplement a principal grant awarded to the applicant, in order to help him or her cover any additional expenses connected with their sojourn in the United States: purchase of books or other materials, attendance at scholarly meetings, or travel for study purposes.

Conditions of application: The applicant should not be older than 35 years; submission of the curriculum vitae; brief statement of the project or study program to be pursued in the United States; information about the principal grant (documented), or how the applicant intends to cover expenses in the United States; at least one reference letter from a senior scholar in the related field; signed commitment of the applicant that he or she shall return to the Czech or Slovak Republic after the completion of the study in the United States; submission of the letter of acceptance by the applicant's educational institution in the United States.
